Karel has also been a recording artist and still brings his standup comedy routine to venues in San Francisco and Monterey.

Karel has authored two books. *You Can't Say That*, a collection of essays frankly addressing a wide range of topics and his most recent publication, *Shouting at Windmills*, *BS From Bush to Obama*, a wide-ranging book of essays that chronicles the end of the Bush Era and Obama to the present. He also contributed to "*When I Knew*" by Robert Trachtenberg, stories of "coming out" directed at gay and lesbian youth.
